The abstracts can be submitted together with the application form or sent separately via APA e-mail.

8. Transport

We expect that most of you will use the Incheon International Airport (airport code ICN). We plan to operate a Free shuttle bus from Incheon Airport to Suncheon for 20 people (First Come First Served). If you would like to use the shuttle bus, please send an email to us. The shuttle is scheduled to depart from Incheon Airport at 4:00 PM August 18th, 2023, so please keep that in mind when booking your flight ticket.

If you cannot use the shuttle bus, please use the following route:

1. Incheon Airport T1/T2 → Suncheon by the nonstop bus
2. Incheon Airport (take Airport Express) → Seoul Station → Suncheon Station
3. Incheon Airport (take bus no. 6770) → Gwangmyeong Station → Suncheon Station
